1. Manjinder has 4 times as many quarters as dimes. In all he has \$2.20. How many of each does he have?
2. Melissa has 3 times as many dimes as nickels. In all she has \$1.40. How many of each does she have?
3. Steve has twice as many toonies as loonies. In all he has \$30. How many of each does he have?
4. Gene has \$2.05 in quarters and dimes. He has 4 more quarters than dimes. How many of each does he have?
5. Kim has 9 more nickels than dimes. If they total \$4.35, how many of each does she have?
6. The school musical charged \$15 for adults and \$10 for students. Twice as many adults bought tickets as students. If they took in a total of \$1640, how many adults bought tickets?

1] 2 dimes, 8 quarters 2] 4 nickels, 12 dimes 3] 6 loonies, 12 toonies 4] 3 dimes, 7 quarters 5] 26 dimes, 35 nickels 6] 82 adults

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
